## Dear Ray:

We are pleased to offer you this quotation for applying a chip seal application to Main Street from the east side of Denver Ave. (at the concrete joint) to the east side of the intersection of Edison Avenue.

The estimated total length of this proposal is 1,710 linear feet of chips st the 42' width since we are skipping the State Avenue intersection. Quantities and unit prices are shown below. We verified our oil pricing this morning with SUNCOR ENERGY and will work until Memorial Day weekend for this project only.

If possible, we would like to advance the timing by one day, and be applying the chips on Wednesday 5/18, or even 5/17 if CDOT striping is removed. Robbie's son has qualified for the State track tournament and he will be gone on 5/19 and 5/20. It would sure be nice to have all our support available on the day we chip.

## **Assumptions Made:**

- CDOT Type II chips (1/2" minus) as supplied to CDOT Maintenance forces in Alamosa.
- CRS-2P oil for chip seal
- CSS-1H oil for fog seal
- Main Street to be closed to all traffic from Denver Ave to mid-block between Edison and Ross
- City forces and Contractor forces work together in cleaning preparation prior to chipping and fog sealing.

• We estimate chipping entire area under either option in one working day, and fog sealing the next day after chip clean-up.

If any additional information is needed, please advise. Thank you for the opportunity to perfrom this work. Working together on projects like this only emphasize to our community the advantage to pooling our resources.
